



SPECIAL TOUR ITINERARY FOR GOLF TOUR AROUND THAILAND

Day 1 - Arrive Bangkok

On arrival in Bangkok, Our local tour guide will welcome you at the airport and take you to your hotel.
In the afternoon, take you to visit The Royal Grand Palace is Bangkok's number one "must see" attraction as well as Thailand's most important landmark. Our guide will take you on an in depth journey through Thailand's history and royal heritage. You will be awed by the grandeur and majesty of the building and its throne halls. And, of course, marvel at the mysterious Emerald Buddha, the most revered Buddha image in Thailand.

Day 2 - Bangkok (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Thai Country Club, for enjoy 18-hole round of golf and return to your hotel.

In the afternoon, let us take you on an exhilarating long tail boat ride through the klongs of Bangkok to Nonthaburi in the far north of the city, where the cityscape turns into countryside and the skyscrapers give way to teak houses, noodle shops, fruit orchards and rice fields. Stop the boat to walk through a bustling local market place and discover a riverside temple with an impressive reclining Buddha far from the tourist crowds. We will often stop for a fresh coconut juice and chat with the locals before cruising back into town.

Day 6 - Chiang Mai - Hua Hin (B)

Depart your hotel and drive north-west of Chiang Mai through the picturesque Mae Sa valley to the Mae Sa Elephant Camp, set in a beautiful, serene wooded area. One of the highlights of your visit is to watch the elephants taking their morning bath in the running streams before starting their days training and work. Along with their trainers the elephants will demonstrate a number of skills for you, and you may take the opportunity to feed them bananas or sugarcane, their favorite treats. Finish your elephant camp visit with a 50 minute elephant ride into the surrounding woods - a real adventure and wonderful experience. Before returning to Chiang Mai, drive to an orchid farm for a visit.

In the afternoon, Transfer to the airport in Chiang Mai for flight to Bangkok

On arrive in Bangkok, our guide will transfer you to Hua Hin.

OPTIONAL TOUR : Full day Sam Roi Yod National Park

Thailand's first Coastal National Park "The Three hundred peaks" is a small but fascinating area of Limestone mountains, coves, beaches, islands and marshy wetlands that is home to a great of plants, birds and some endangered animals. A wonderful and not too difficult place to explore. Our journey starts with a visit to a pineapple plantation.?? We travel on to Bang-Pu fishing village, where we take a boat ride out through the village to the open sea.?? (subject to sea conditions). Take in Bang-Pu's thriving fishing industry, preparing for the day catch. Our 20 minutes boat trip concludes at a beautiful stretch of beach below the Pra-Ya-Na-korn Cave. Good walking shoes are recommended as we then walk 430 meter up to the cave dome.?? Once inside we can see the dripping stalagmites around the pavilion built by King Rama V. After lunch we have time to relax and swim in the warm sea.
